This volume of Resenhas, dedicated to Taro Yoshizawa (1919-1996), contains reports from the Workshop on Differential Equations and Nonlinear Analysis held in Águas de Lindóia, Brazil, October 28-November 1, 1996.

Throughout his illustrious career, Yoshizawa dedicated his research to the basic understanding of stability theory and the existence of periodic and almost periodic solutions of ordinary and functional differential equations.
