In 2020, we celebrated the 39th edition of our University Medical Congress (COMU), organized by the Scientific Department of the Faculdade de Medicina da Universidade de São Paulo (DC FMUSP). It is the largest scientific meeting in Brazil for health science's students.

This year, in an unprecedented form, COMU has been adapted to accommodate over 50 courses and workshops, covering issues that called the attention of students from all areas of health sciences and from all undergraduate levels. All these maintaining social distancing, given the COVID-19 pandemic. The entire Congress had its class models modified, so we could accommodate it in a virtual model.
