In 2022, we celebrated the 41st edition of our University Medical Congress (COMU), organized by the Scientific Department of the Faculdade de Medicina da Universidade de São Paulo (DC FMUSP). It is the largest scientific meeting in Brazil for health science's students.

This year, for the first time, COMU has been adapted to accommodate over 66 courses and workshops, covering issues that called the attention of students from all areas of health sciences and from all undergraduate levels. In addition, the Congress has been designed in a modular way, so that each student could create the program that best suited his/her knowledge and interests.

In its XLI edition, the congress was once again an in-person event inside the Faculdade de Medicina da USP and Institutes of the Hospital das Clínicas of FMUSP. Four online courses were also made available (Medical Clinic, Emergencies in Psychiatry, Nephrology and Clinical Emergencies), with the aim of providing access to medical scientific knowledge for academics across the country.

At the COMU Awards, we have received scientific papers from students from all over Brazil. In order to encourage internationalization and exchange, since 2016 the official language of the event is English. The Selection Committees for the different awards were composed by highly knowledgeable FMUSP professors. All award prizes were sponsored by Fundação Faculdade de Medicina (FFM).

In the present issue of Revista de Medicina, edited by our Scientific Department, we include all the abstracts presented orally at the Scientific Awards sessions. This Journal covers articles that address relevant issues to the scientific community, which has been ongoing for over a century.

Finally, we thank the Scientific Department and Revista de Medicina staff for their help and support, always essential to our Congress, and congratulate all participating students for their dedication to research and science.
